CERTIFICATE IV OVERVIEW

The specialised Bowen training for Certificate IV is taught by qualified Instructors based around Australia. Please visit <http://www.bowentraining.com.au> to locate a course and instructor near you.

Entry Requirements

Applicants must be aged 18 years or over.

Certificate IV is divided into two components:

Practical Learning

- This is comprised of **seven**, two-day, Instructor-led classroom modules that are completed sequentially.
- Modules 1 to 7 take the student step by step through the Bowen training, introducing new procedures to address a wide range of problems that clients may present with.
- Each Module is delivered over **two days**, with each training day considered to be **8 hours**.
- **100 Logbook hours** to be completed outside of class – students are required to **locate** a minimum of 10 people to work on for the 100 Logbook hours. The people treated as part of the Logbook hours must not be used for the 10 Case Studies.

Recognition of Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) A student may be eligible to gain recognition for previous learning or skills development gained through work and life experiences. The student must contact the BTA office to begin this process.

Credit Transfer (CT)

A student may obtain recognition by BTA for the 'formal' study they have previously completed that is relevant to the Certificate IV Bowen Therapy. The student must contact the BTA office to begin this process.

**TRAINING SCHEDULE OPTIONS****Required Timeframe**

Classes can be taken to suit your own timetable; however the Certificate IV must be completed within a minimum of **12** months and a maximum of **18** months. This timeframe allows plenty of time to revise and consolidate techniques between modules.

The **minimum time** for completion of the 7 practical modules is the equivalent of **one module per month**. We recommend each student should complete their practical modules within 7 and 10 months. The completion of the logbook of hour's, case studies, and professional reflection may take longer.

Please note: minimum class numbers are required for the classes to go ahead.
